

### Tracey's achievements...

- Helped build 'Suraksha Central' - a platform aimed at increasing awareness and responsibility towards child protection; through:
  - **Research and Development** - to understand receptivity of products due to be launched as part of the platform; to design recommendations on development and strategy for the platform
  - **Interaction with internal and external stakeholders** - to update the monitoring tools, to author business requirements documents and to review the progress of the project with internal and external teams
  - **Partnership** - to explore, define and build partnerships to increase locus of impact

### ... contributing to Aangan Trust

- Assisted the leadership team define and build following tools that are part of 'Suraksha Central': 1. monitoring tools aimed at improving child safety in communities, schools and rescue homes as well as, 2. a tool aimed at increasing ownership of police officials with regards to women and child rights
- Authored a Leadership Curriculum for Community Leaders, along with the program team at Aangan Trust
- Facilitated gender sensitization workshop for partner organizations and adolescent volunteers, estimated to impact 6500 children
