

- 2 out of 3 mothers who die during pregnancy or birth are located in sub-Saharan Africa.
- Nearly 350 children a day contract HIV in sub-Saharan Africa during pregnancy, childbirth, or the breastfeeding period.
- There is a shortage of 4.2M HCWs

The solution [your org] provides...

m2m trains and employs HIV positive people as peer mentors community healthcare workers who provide maternal and child health services, with a special focus on the prevention of mother to child transmission of HIV, in understaffed health clinics and communities.





- Strengthened the country-specific engagement plan for the Mozambique country program to incorporate more individual, corporate and multilateral/bilateral funding streams
